I. Call to Order	WELCOME
II. Review of a variance from Don Henry of the Bureau of Environmental Services (BES) for SW Terwilliger Boulevard and Powers Court Sanitary Sewer Extension Project. The Bureau of Environmental Services will construct a public sanitary sewer line in SW Terwilliger Boulevard. The eight-inch sewer line will extend 6,800 feet from the Terwilliger Pump Station at SW Powers Court south to the 30-inch diameter Tryon Interceptor where it crosses under Highway 43. The noise variance BES is requesting would extend normal construction hours to 7:00 p.m. for up to 60 days of construction and to 10:00 p.m. for up to ten days. The bureau is also asking permission for overnight construction from 9:00 p.m. to 7:00 a.m. for up to 15 nights for grinding, paving and striping at the end of the project. The construction phase of the project is expected to last up to six months from spring 2013 to fall 2013. Two sections of the project are in Portland city limits. One is a 1,500 foot long section from SW Powers Court south to the Multnomah County line. The second is a 275-foot long section near the border between Multnomah and Clackamas counties at SW Castleridge Lane. Environmental Services estimates that about one-fourth of the project construction will take place within the Portland city limits.	Review and approve, change, or modify
