Stewardship Incentive Application

The Community Watershed Stewardship Program provides gift certificates to community groups or individuals needing seed money for restoration projects. These stewardship projects must bring together volunteers for an overall goal of enhancing water quality in Portland's watersheds. Please verify that your project meets the following criteria:

Community Groups (maximum amount \$300)

- Defined as public and private non-profits
 - Volunteer oriented
 - Plantings native to the Willamette valley
 - Provides community benefit
 - High visibility

Private landowners (maximum amount \$50)

- Streamside property in a designated Environmental Zone
 - Already making progress (invasive removal, volunteering with local nature groups)
 - Plants are part of a larger process of restoration
 - Planting native to the area
 - Commitment to education/naturescaping
- Stormwater Facility
 - Project structure completed or nearly completed
 - Project already approved by city code
