
## **Heritage Trees of Portland**

SHAGBARK HICKORY (Carya ovata) JUGLANDACEAE

- Native to eastern North America.
- Height can exceed 130'.
- Leaves are compound with usually 5 leaflets. Leaves can be 14" long.
- Nuts ripen in Portland and are best tasting of all hickories.
- Bark is in shaggy plates and is grayish.
- Wood is very heavy, hard, strong, tough, close-grained, and elastic.
- Uncommon in Portland.
