Heritage Trees of Portland

AMERICAN ASH (Fraxinus americana) OLEACEAE

- Native to the eastern half of the U.S. and southern Ontario.
- Height can reach over 100'.
- Compound leaves usually with 7-9 leaflets that are pale beneath (another common name is White ash).
- Dioecious with flowers appearing before leaves.
- Bark has diamond-shaped ridges.
- Uncommon along Portland's streets.
