Heritage Trees of Portland

ENGLISH WALNUT (Juglans regia) JUGLANDACEAE

- Native to Poland and east to much of Asia.
- Can exceed 100' but usually shorter; spread often equals height.
- Compound leaves with 5-9 leaflets.
- Flowers, like all Juglans, are catkins. Fruit is well-known nut.
- Bark on mature trees is gray, smooth plates.
- Fall color of no consequence.
- Fairly common in Portland, especially in older neighborhoods.
