



Heritage Trees of Portland

EASTERN WHITE PINE (*Pinus strobus*) PINACEAE

- Native to eastern North America.
- In wild can reach 200', usually <100' in cities.
- Needles 5 to a bundle, soft, 3-5.5" long, silvery.
- Seed cones 4-8" long, slightly curved, slender, pitchy.
- Overall this tree has a soft look to it.
- Somewhat uncommon in Portland.
