



Heritage Trees of Portland

CANYON LIVE OAK (*Quercus chrysolepis*) FAGACEAE

- Native from southwest Oregon, California, Baja, to Texas.
- Height can reach 100' but usually less.
- Leaves evergreen, 1-4" long; some have smooth margins, others spiny like holly; shiny on top, golden fuzz/felt beneath.
- Acorns 1-2" long, cup covered with golden wool.
- Very rare in Portland. This Heritage Tree was brought from California on a flat-bed truck in the 1920s and planted by Thomas Autzen at his house.
