



Heritage Trees of Portland

SCARLET OAK (*Quercus coccinea*) FAGACEAE

- Native to eastern U.S.
- Height can exceed 150', more often not so tall.
- Leaves have pointy lobes (5-7) and deep, C-shaped sinuses; glossy green above, paler beneath.
- Acorns ovoid, 0.5-1", cup goes halfway down.
- Fall foliage is scarlet.
- Uncommon in Portland.
