

## **Heritage Trees of Portland**

WILLOW OAK (Quercus phellos) FAGACEAE

- Native to southeast U.S.
- Height can reach 160' in native habitat.
- Leaves resemble willow leaves, can reach 7" in length.
- Acorns 1.5" long, squat, round; cap covers top one-third.
- Fall foliage yellow.
- Rare in Portland.
