



## Heritage Trees of Portland

### CHESTNUT OAK (*Quercus prinus*) FAGACEAE

- Native from northeast to mid-south U.S.
- Height can reach 100'.
- Leaves 4-10" long; shiny, yellow-green, smooth above, pale green and hairy beneath. Margin wavy with large, rounded teeth (10-12).
- Acorns 1-1.5", dark shiny brown; cup covers half way.
- Fall color yellow to orange.
- Very rare in Portland. This Heritage Tree was planted as a seedling in 1904.
