ORDINANCE No. 178013

* Authorize Memorandum of Understanding and Reimbursement Agreement with the Portland Office of the Federal Bureau of Investigation to participate in the Portland Joint Terrorism Task Force. (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. The Memorandum of Understanding (Exhibit A) and Reimbursement Agreement (Exhibit B) establish and delineate the mission of the Portland Joint Terrorism Task Force ("PJTTF") as a joint cooperative effort.
- 2. The two agreements formalize a relationship between the Portland FBI Domestic Terrorism Squad and the Portland Police Bureau to better address criminal extremist activity which would fall under the investigative responsibility of either agency.
- 3. The mission of the PJTTF is to identify and target for prosecution those individuals or groups who are responsible for acts of criminal terrorism.
- 4. The PJTTF will enhance coordinated initiatives by seeking the most effective use of federal, state and local law enforcement resources to investigate and prosecute criminal offenders.
- 5. The City will bill the Federal Bureau of Investigation according to the Reimbursement Agreement attached as Exhibit B.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

a. The Mayor and Chief of Police are hereby authorized to execute a Memorandum of Understanding and a Reimbursement Agreement between the City of Portland and the Federal Bureau of Investigation in the form of the attached Exhibits A and B.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists in that the current Portland Joint Task Force Memorandum of Understanding and Reimbursement Agreement expired on September 30, 2003 and immediate effectiveness of this Ordinance is necessary in order to avoid undue disruption of the cooperative effort of the Portland Joint Terrorism Task Force.
