Re: Nine Month Drug Impact Area Report

Dear Mayor Adams and City Commissioners:

The numbers for the first nine months of operation of the Drug Impact Area (DIA) program have now been assembled. Attached is a report which explains those numbers. Some highlights of the report show:

- 24% (400 of 1,602) of all county drug arrests involving heroin, cocaine and marijuana occurred in the relatively small areas that constitute the DIAs.
- 79 % (95 of 121) of those arrested in the DIAs for drug dealing resided outside the areas and had come into the areas to sell drugs.
- The court imposed DIA exclusions as a condition of probation in all 417 cases (381 distinct defendants) where the exclusion was requested.
- In addition to services provided by the STOP drug treatment court and the county probation department, 40% (152 of 381) of those excluded from the DIAs qualified for Service Coordination Team services.
- Minorities comprised 43% of the persons arrested for drug offenses in the DIAs as compared to 38% of the persons arrested outside the DIAs.
